### INTERNSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

The World Organisation Against Torture (OMCT), the largest international coalition of non governmental organisations fighting against torture, summary executions, forced disappearance and all other forms of cruel, inhuman and degrading treatment, is currently seeking to recruit a **FULL TIME INTERN** for the Urgent Campaigns and the Observatory for the Protection of Human Rights Defenders.

The positions should be filled as soon as possible. Duration of the internship: minimum 3 months.

Please note that internships are not remunerated.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

The incumbent will work under the supervision of both the Coordinators of the Urgent Campaigns and the Observatory for the Protection of Human Rights Defenders. The activities of the intern include:

- To draft urgent interventions in cases involving general victims and human rights defenders (in Spanish, English and/or French).
- To maintain contact with organisations affiliated to OMCT.
- To attend meetings and sessions of the United Nations human rights mechanisms.
- To assist with the organisation of field missions.
- To assist with the organisation of seminars and conferences.
- To translate documents.
- To assist the Coordinators with other activities of the Urgent Campaigns and the Observatory for the Protection of Human Rights Defenders.

- Good knowledge of UN procedures and regional mechanisms for the protection of human rights
- Excellent drafting and editing skills
- Ability to work under pressure to meet deadlines
- Capacity to adapt to multidisciplinary work in a multicultural environment

- Spanish mother tongue or excellent knowledge of Spanish (written and oral)
- Fluency in French and/or English
