In past months, violations against human rights defenders and NGOs have continued unabated in a number of OSCE countries. Human rights defenders have been harassed, jailed, attacked, killed. NGOs have been forced to close and their bank accounts have been frozen due to draconian NGO laws. LGBTI rights defenders have been slandered, criminalised and attacked.

Representatives from human rights organisations of AZERBAIJAN, BELARUS, KYRGYZSTAN, and the RUSSIAN FEDERATION will analyse the challenges they face in their day-to-day work.

Concrete recommendations in terms of implementation and monitoring of the OSCE/ODIHR Guidelines will be formulated.
