In November 2009, the United Nations (UN) Committee against Torture (CAT) will examine Colombia at its 43rd session. In light of this, the Colombian Coalition against Torture (*Coalición Colombiana contra la Tortura*)<sup>1</sup>, an entity that seeks to foster the work of Colombian human rights NGOs, submitted an alternative report on the situation of torture and other forms of ill-treatment in Colombia since November 2003, date of the last examination of Colombia by the CAT.

The report submitted by the Coalition entails information that shows that the use of torture and other forms of ill-treatment in Colombia is widespread and systematic. Furthermore, it confirms that Colombia has still not implemented the recommendations issued by the CAT in 2003. The report proposes a number of recommendations to Colombia to redress the situation and ensure compliance with the provisions of the Convention against Torture and other cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment.
