The position should be filled as soon as possible and the length of the internships should be minimum 3 months.

Please note that internships are not remunerated.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Activities of the position include:

- To assist with the preparation and follow-up of individual communications submitted to the United Nations treaty bodies (in Spanish, French and/or English).
- To carry out research on the implementation of international human rights law in he Democratic Republic of the Congo.
- To assist with the organisation of training sessions for women human rights defenders in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.
- To attend meetings and sessions of the United Nations human rights mechanisms.
- To assist in other activities linked with litigation.

- Good knowledge of UN procedures and regional mechanisms for the protection of human rights.
- Excellent drafting and editing skills.
